[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 28.04.2021 in CWP-PIL No.77 of 2021.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that order (Annexure P-1) dated 28.04.2021 in CWP-PIL No.77 of 2021, directing that orders of eviction, dispossession, demolition etc passed by the High Court or any Court subordinate to it or any Tribunal or Judicial or Quasi Judicial forum which had remained unexecuted be kept in abeyance till 30.06.2021 was intentionally and willfully violated by the respondents but pursuant to issuance of notice to the respondents, amicable settlement of the dispute has been arrived at between the parties, therefore, the

permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
