The plaintiffs' application for striking off the written statement filed by the subsequent purchasers from the record has been dismissed. The petitioners claim that respondent no.4 and 5 are subsequent purchasers, therefore, they have no right to file the written statement. As already noticed, the written statement has already been filed on 07.02.2019. There is no provision for striking off the written statement, which is already a part of the record. Its effect shall be examined by the court at an appropriate stage. The petitioners have also failed to draw the attention of the Court to any prejudice caused. Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.
