[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 27.09.2021 in CWP No.19458 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.19458 of 2021 was disposed of by directing respondent No.1 therein to decide the statutory appeal of the petitioner dated 14/17.07.2020 with three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned Addl. A.G. has produced copy of order, dated 31.05.2022 passed by the respondent remanding the case to the appointing authority/disciplinary authority to pass fresh orders after following the prescribed procedure laid down under Rule 12. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with

liberty to pursue the matter before the appointing authority/disciplinary authority in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
