Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.0013 dated 10.08.2019 registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 506 and 120-B IPC (Sections 376, 354 and 511 IPC added later on) at Police Station NRI, district Kapurthala.

Since investigation in the case is still going on, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage he would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Investigating Officer in the aforesaid FIR to consider the averments made in the present petition before finalizing the investigation in the FIR in question.

Learned State counsel has no objection if the afore prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted.

Finding the prayer made on behalf of the petitioners to be

reasonable as also in the light of no objection by the learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Investigating Officer in FIR No.0013 dated 10.08.2019 registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 506 and 120-B IPC (Sections 376, 354 and 511 IPC added later on) at Police Station NRI, district Kapurthala to consider the averments made in the present petition before finalizing investigation in the aforesaid FIR.
