[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 07.04.2022 in CWP No.7376 of 2022 in case titled as Sukhvinder and ors. Vs. State of Haryana and ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 07.04.2022 reveals that CWP No.7376 of 2022 was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation dated 31.03.2022 filed by the petitioners in accordance with law within one week from the date of order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners states that respondent No.2 has decided representation dated 31.03.2022 filed by the petitioners vide order dated 27.06.2022, therefore, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to the petitioners

to challenge order dated 27.06.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No.2 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
