The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C is for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for getting a free and fair investigation conducted in FIR No.11, dated 31.01.2018, registered under Sections 420 IPC (offence under Section 406 IPC added later on), at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

None appears for the petitioner.

Mr. Anterpreet Singh, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.5 and filed his Vakalatnama. The same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for respondent No.5 states that this is the second petition filed by the petitioner for the similar relief, the first petition bearing CRM-M No.3916 of 2021 having been dismissed on 12.07.2022.

The said order is reproduced herein below:-
