This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioner No.1 was earlier married to one Nasib Dass, who expired on 13.01.2018; that both the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6; that it is the first marriage of petitioner No.2 and the second marriage of petitioner No.1, and that a male child born out of the wedlock of first marriage of petitioner No.1 with Nasib Dass, is being looked after by his grand-parents. The certificate evidencing their marriage, is on record as Annexure P-3. The petitioners have submitted the representation dated 18.05.2022 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, for redressal of their grievance.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3-State only, at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the present petition with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, to decide the representation dated 18.05.2022 (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioners, and grant protection to them, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
