In the present petition, prayer of the petitioner is for computing the work-charge service rendered by the petitioner from 28.01.1981 till 08.08.1990 as a qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits, keeping in view the settled principle of law as settled by the Full Bench of this Court in '*Kesar Chand Vs. State of Punjab and others*', *AIR 1988 Punjab 265*.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said benefit has not been given to the petitioner and his pensionary benefits have been calculated without giving him the benefit of said service, which is arbitrary.

Learned counsel of the petitioner submits that the claim as raised in the present petition has already been raised by him in his representation dated 05.11.2021 (Annexure P-3), which is still pending consideration before the authorities concerned and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Advocate, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 05.11.2021 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the claim which has been raised by him in the representation dated 05.11.2021 (Annexure P-3), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the same within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.
