The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing order dated 21.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) passed by the respondent; whereby the petitioner has been ordered to be transferred from 25th Battalion Delhi to 11th Battalion Ranikhet (Uttarakhand), without considering his medical problem.

Perusal of the previous orders show that the petitioner has not been appearing in the matter, except on one date. Moreover, counsel for the respondents-UOI has contended that the request of the petitioner has since been acceded to.

In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present writ petition any more.
