Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of complaint No.147/2016 dated 23.02.2016 registered under Sections 18 (C), 18-A punishable under Sections 27 (b) (ii) and 28 Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940, summoning order dated 03.02.2016 as well as charge sheet dated 08.09.2016.

Learned State counsel assisted by Mr. Anurag, Drug Inspector Fazilka, has produced the orders dated 19.10.2021 and 21.04.2022 passed by trial Court to contend that the trial is fixed for adducing defence evidence.

Considering the above advanced stage of the trial, no case is made out for exercise of inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.
