Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking direction to official respondents No.1 to 3 to decide the representation dated 05.05.2022, Annexure P-2, submitted by the petitioner against respondents No.4 and 5.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was married to Simranpreet Singh, respondent No.4, on 23.01.2022. She has referred to Marriage Certificate, Annexure P-1. She submits that after marriage, her husband and mother-in-law, respondent No.5, have been harassing and ill-treating her as they were not satisfied with the dowry. She submits that a representation dated 05.05.2022 has been submitted to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, respondent No.2, which is not being attended to. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the same.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on their behalf.

Having considered the matter, but without examining the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine the representation, Annexure P-2, and take suitable action thereon, as warranted in accordance with law.
