SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

On 27.05.2022, this Court passed the following order:-

“Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking issuance of direction to learned Additional Sessions Judge (Fast Track Special Court) to admit the petitioners on bail in the event of their appearance in the Court in view of their having been summoned as additional accused in FIR No.151 dated 17.07.2020 at P.S. Ismailabad, District Kurukshetra under Section 304-B/34 IPC, which were deleted later on and instead Section 306, IPC was added.

It has been contended that the petitioners, who are the parents-in-law and widow sister-in-law of the deceased, were found to be innocent during investigation and they have been summoned as additional accused vide order dated 23.11.2021 (Annexure P-2) passed on an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. Counsel argues that although the FIR was registered under Section 304-B IPC, but on conclusion of investigation, challan has been presented against the husband of the deceased under Section 306 IPC. It has been submitted that the petitioners are ready to surrender before the Trial Court and join the proceedings.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Mahima Yashpal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

*Petitioners are directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and join the proceeding. In case they do so, the Trial Court shall release them on ad-interim bail subject to their furnishing adequate surety/bail bonds to its satisfaction.
List on 25.08.2022. ”*

Counsel for the petitioners has filed a copy of order dated 31.05.2022 to submit that the petitioners have surrendered before the trial court and have joined the proceedings. He submits that the petitioners have been admitted to ad interim bail.

In view of the above, order dated 27.05.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute and present petition is disposed of.
