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**MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (Oral)**

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 90, dated 15.04.2021, lodged under Sections 498-A, 406 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala (annexed as Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel submits that pursuant to order dated 24<sup>th</sup> November, 2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He has also submitted that the FIR in question, which emanates from a matrimonial dispute between the parties stands amicably settled between them.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation. He, on further instructions submits that since the petitioner has joined investigation, his further investigation, much less, custodial interrogation is not required.

Heard.

In the facts and circumstances, as enumerated hereinabove, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 24<sup>th</sup> November, 2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
