The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in FIR No.90 dated 15.3.2022 registered under Sections 354, 354-A, 354-B, 354-C, 506, 379-B(1), 148, 149 IPC (section 201 IPC added later on) and sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station, City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

By virtue of the order dated 24.5.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 24.5.2022 petitioners have joined investigation and fully cooperated and thus the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 24.5.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
