1. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner for a considerable duration of time, this Court does not feel inclined to either issue notice to the respondent, or, to grant any indulgence of any interim relief. However, in case there is a valid change in circumstances from today, upto the subsequent date, thereupon, it is open to the petitioner to recanvass appropriate remedies, in accordance with law.

2. Moreover, it is also open to the petitioner, to move an application before the learned trial Judge concerned, asking for a direction being made upon the investigating officer, to ensure re-weighing of the contraband.

3. The petition is dismissed with the aforesaid observations.
