HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner had earlier filed CRWP-2047-2022 seeking directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla, to protect his life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 10 in the said petition. That petition was disposed of vide order dated 08.03.2022, with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla, to look into his grievance as per law.

It is the case of the petitioner that even after the disposal of the said writ petition, respondents No.6 to 20, who are the relatives of the wife of the petitioner, forcibly entered the house of the petitioner and beat him. In this regard, FIR No.64 dated 08.05.2022, under Sections 341, 323,324,452,506,447,511,148 and 149 IPC, Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Malerkotla, has been registered.

The subsisting grievance of the petitioner is that he apprehends danger to his life at the hands of private respondents. In this regards, he has already submitted a representation dated 13.05.2022 (Annexure P-6)

addressed amongst others to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla.

Without opining on the veracity of the allegations, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the representation (Annexure P-6) with regard to the danger to the life and liberty of the petitioner.
