Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of impugned order dated 27.08.2018 passed by Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga (Annexure P-2), whereby, the petitioner has been declared as Proclaimed Offender.

After arguing for sometime, counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the petition, at this stage. He, however, requests that the petitioner will surrender before the Trial Court, join the proceedings and file a petition seeking grant of regular bail, which may be ordered to be decided in a time bound manner.

Request of counsel for the petitioner has been considered.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the Trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and moves a petition seeking grant of regular bail, the Trial Court shall make an endeavour and decide it within a period of one week of its filing.

Petition is disposed of.
