VIVEK PURI, J.(ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking to quash the FIR No. 101 dated 03.07.2017 under Sections 306 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Harjit Singh, submits that petitioners No. 2 to 5 were found to be innocent and on conclusion of investigation, challan has been presented only against petitioner No.1. It has been further submitted that petitioner No.1 has already been acquitted in terms of judgment dated 25.11.2019 passed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur. Consequently, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the categoric assertion made by learned State counsel, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioners. They shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of three months, if the aforesaid assertion of learned State counsel is found to be factually incorrect.
