Rapat No.596 dated 06.06.2014 was prepared regarding a private partition. Allegedly the said rapat was forged. Complaints were accordingly made for registration of a criminal case but nothing was done. A petition was filed in the High Court for registration of a criminal case which was disposed of with certain directions. These directions were not complied with and accordingly contempt petition was filed which is still pending. Meanwhile, representation dated 01.04.2022 has been made to respondent No.2 for correction of revenue record by deletion of the rapat aforementioned but the same has not been done. Thus, the present writ petition has been filed.

As yet, no authority has returned a finding that the rapat aforementioned was forged. Thus, representation made by the petitioner can not be accepted. No directions can be issued by this Court, directing

respondent No.2 to take any action upon the representation.

Being meritless, the present writ petition is dismissed.
