Prayer in the present petitioner is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.243 dated 08.11.2020 under Sections 22 and 29 Added later on, (Act No.61 of 1985) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that recovery effected from Satyam Kumar is 1500 intoxicant tablets which were alleged to be purchased from the petitioner; that the petitioner has been falsely involved in the present case and no recovery has been effected from the petitioner: that he has been in custody for more than one year and 2 months.

Learned State counsel while opposing the petition submits that as per the custody certificate, there are two more NDPS cases registered against the petitioner, though, he is on bail in those cases. He further submits that the petitioner is a habitual offender and no case for grant of bail is made out.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the fact that there are two more cases of similar nature registered and pending against the petitioner, this Court do not find any ground to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
