Petitioner seeks four weeks' parole on account of marriage of his real brother. Petitioner has been convicted and sentenced to life imprisonment for the offences punishable under Section 302 read with Section 34 and Section 392 read with Sections 34 and 376 IPC, vide judgment and order dated 27.04.2013 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram.

It is submitted that the petitioner has earlier been released on parole on various occasions and he has never misused the concession at any point of time and there is no reason whatsoever for denial of the benefit.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 04.06.2022 of Sh. Dinesh Kumar, Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Gurugram, filed in Court today, is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Learned counsel for the State submits that parole case of the petitioner has been initiated as per Section 3 of the Haryana Good Conduct

Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act 2022 and forwarded to the District Magistrate Varanasi (UP) as well as Commissioner, Gurugram Division, Gurugram and final decision is still awaited.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this criminal writ petition is disposed of at this stage, with a direction to the competent authority, to decide representation dated 13.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) petitioner's parole case by passing a speaking order, within one week from today.

A copy of the decision be conveyed to the petitioner.
