Through this petition, the petitioner seeks cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2, vide orders dated 06.05.2022 and 09.05.2022 passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Chandigarh, in case bearing FIR No.12 dated 30.01.2022, registered at Police Station North, U.T. Chandigarh, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323 and 506 IPC and Sections 307 IPC (added later on).

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 06.05.2022 passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Chandigarh, respondent No.2 had been granted interim bail and directed to join investigation. The aforesaid order dated 06.05.2022, granting interim bail to respondent No.2, was made absolute, vide order dated 09.05.2022. At the first instance, the petitioner ought to have approached learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Chandigarh, for cancellation of bail by filing an application under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Chandigarh, first, if so advised, for cancellation of bail granted to respondent No.2.
