The petitioner herein had approached this Court seeking appointment to the post of Male Constable (General Duty) pursuant to advertisement No.8/2015 dated 17.07.2015 (Annexure P-1) by contending that he had participated under the said selection process and would have necessary marks for appointment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that detail marks secured by the petitioner were not ever supplied to him and on the website of the Commission, his candidature has been shown as rejected.

Pursuant to notice of motion having been issued on 01.05.2019, the result of the petitioner has been produced in Court today in a sealed cover, which would reflect that he secured total 62.55 marks on the basis of marks given to him under different categories. The final result sheet of the petitioner

along with total result dated 09.08.2019 and 23.06.2017, produced by the learned State counsel are made part of the record.

Learned State counsel would submit that the final merit list for the post of Male Constable (General Duty) under advertisement No.8/2015 in category No.1 stood revised after the addition of 500 SBC posts being converted in the general category. As per the revised merit list, the last selected candidate has a merit of 64.50 marks and, therefore, on account of not having adequate merit, the petitioner herein could not be considered.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Total marks of the petitioner herein tabulated to be 62.55 do not entitle him to be considered in general category for being selected.

Consequently, the instant writ petition is dismissed.
