Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal complaint No.CHA/90239/2012 titled Gurbir Singh v. Maheshinder Singh Grewal and others in which the petitioner has been summoned by the trial Court under Sections 417, 465, 468, 471, 472, 477A IPC

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has joined the proceedings before the trial Court in light of order of interim bail passed by this Court.

Mr. Rahul Rampal who has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 has not refuted the fact that the petitioner has joined the proceedings before the trial Court on the basis of the order of interim bail passed by this Court. However, counsel for respondent No.2 has been

resisting the present petition.

I have heard the counsel for the parties.

Admittedly, the petitioner has joined the proceedings before the trial Court in the aforesaid complaint case. No purpose is going to be served even if at this point of time, the petitioner is sent to custody.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 25.5.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. The petitioner is further directed to appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing fixed in the aforesaid complaint case.
