Civil writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the service rendered by petitioners on daily wages towards pensionary benefits.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for petitioners, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case legal notice dated 03.02.2022 (P-2) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Director, Social Justice Empowerment and Minorities, Punjab to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice in

accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
