Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.16 dated 28.03.2022, registered for offences under Sections 363, 366-A, 376-DA, 344 and 509 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 6 and 17 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, at Police Station Talwandi Bhai, District Ferozepur, Annexure P-1.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 31.05.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

This fact has been ascertained by the State counsel upon instructions received from ASI, Dilbag Singh. He further submits that the petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation. He has placed on

record a copy of order dated 10.08.2022 passed by the Trial Court to submit that main accused, Rinku alias Sandeep Singh, has been acquitted of the charges framed against him.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the FIR, present petition is allowed.

Order dated 31.05.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
