MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J.(Oral)

The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.68 dated 09.03.2021 registered at Police Station Nangal Chaudhary, District Mahendergarh, under Section 25 of the Arms Act.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Surender Singh, from above-said Police Station, apprises the Court that though in compliance of the orders dated 20.07.2021 and 17.09.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation but he is not co-operating with Investigating Agency.

A perusal of the file reveals that vide the order dated 20.07.2021 as passed by the Co-ordinate Bench, the petitioner was granted the relief of interim bail with direction to him to join the investigation within 07 days. However, on 17.09.2021, learned State counsel had apprised the Court that though in compliance of above-said order, the petitioner had

joined the investigation but the recovery of the pistol and the cartridges was still to be effected. Accordingly, vide the order as passed on that day, the petitioner was again directed to join in the investigation within 10 days but as mentioned in the preceding paragraph, he has not co-operated the investigating agency.

Keeping in view all the afore-discussed facts and circumstances, this Court is of the considered opinion that the petitioner does not deserve the relief of anticipatory bail. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed accordingly.
