**RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):**

This petition has been filed by the petitioner being aggrieved by the decision dated 20.07.2020, whereby his admission in the MD PG degree course in forensic science was rejected on the ground that he is medically unfit.

Upon being confronted with the fact that the admission relates to the year 2020-2021, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition has become infructuous and be disposed of, as such, keeping the question of law, involved in the petition, open for adjudication in an appropriate case, as and when occasion arises.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3, submits that they are re-considering the guidelines relating to the physically handicapped person in terms of the order passed by the Delhi High Court in W.P.(C) 2815 of 2022

& CM Appl. 8123 of 2022, decided on 18.04.2022, is taken on record.

Learned Standing Counsel appearing for respondents No.1 and 2 submits that in case the petitioner approaches them for return of original documents, the same would be taken up by the authorities and the documents would be returned to him, in accordance with law.

In the wake of the above, the petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, in the above terms.
