[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 17.02.2022, in CWP No.11493 of 2019 in case titled as '**Suresh Kumar and others** versus **Municipal Corporation, Sonapat and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that the petitioners had challenged notices dated 25.10.2017, 19.01.2018 and orders dated 12.02.2018 and 14.12.2018 whereby the petitioner's flour mill had been ordered to be sealed by the Municipal Corporation, Sonapat.

[3] The aforementioned writ petition was disposed of by directing the Municipal Corporation, Sonapat, to pass final orders in the matter, positively within one month after grant of opportunity of hearing to the concerned.

[4] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case.

[5] Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 17.02.2022 in CWP No.11493 of 2019, the respondent has

passed order dated 23.05.2022, rejecting claim of the petitioner for reopening of the sealed premises.

[6] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to challenge order dated 23.05.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[7] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
