Mr. K.L. Saini, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and has filed Memorandum of Appearance in Court, which is taken on record.

Service is complete.

On 26.05.2022, this Court passed the following order:-

“Instant appeal has been filed under Section 14-A(2) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (for short “SC&ST Act”) challenging order dated 29.04.2022 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bhiwani, whereby anticipatory bail of the appellant was dismissed.

Counsel for the appellant contends that the appellant was not named in the FIR, Annexure A-1, and was found to be innocent during the investigation. He submits that the appellant has been summoned as an additional accused vide order dated 22.10.2021, Annexure A-2, for offence under Sections 323, 341, IPC and Section 3 of SC&ST Act. Counsel submits that the appellant is ready to surrender and join the proceedings.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Mahima Yashpal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State-respondent No.1.

In case, the petitioner surrenders before the Trial Court and joins the proceedings on or before 06.06.2022, the next date before the Trial Court, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court concerned.

List on 26.07.2022.

Respondent No.2 be served for the date fixed.”

Counsel for the appellant has placed on record a certified copy of order dated 06.06.2022 passed by the trial court and has submitted that the appellant has surrendered before the trial court, joined the proceedings and has been released on interim bail.

In view of the above, present appeal is disposed of and order dated 26.05.2022 granting interim bail to the appellant is made absolute.
