This petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking quashing of FIR No.423 dated 24.04.2019 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 406/506 of IPC registered at Police Station Chandni Bagh, District Panipat, along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR and also the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.
