Present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take action on the representation dated 21.03.2022 (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioner, against respondent No.4 and two unidentified persons.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with one Ranjit Singh-son of respondent No.4, on 19.06.2010; that out of the said wedlock, a male child, namely, Prathamjot Singh was born on 19.03.2013; that husband of the petitioner is now living in Spain; that the petitioner has also filed a divorce petition against her husband, which is now pending adjudication; that respondent No.4-father-in-law of the petitioner, who is residing in Gurdaspur, tried to kidnap her son on 12.03.2022, and that respondent No.4 while sitting in the car, was also seen in the CCTV footage.

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Vide order dated 26.05.2022 passed by this Court, respondent No.3-Station House Officer, Police Women Station, Jalandhar, was directed to record the statement of respondent No.4-Gurbax Singh, father-in-law of the petitioner, with regard to the allegations made by her in the present petition.

Learned State counsel submits that as per the statement of respondent No.4, recorded in pursuance of the aforesaid order, after executing an agreement to sell the land on 12.03.2022, he (respondent No.4) was going back, his grand-son standing outside a shop, had called him; that he had no option but to meet his grand-son; that he had no intention of kidnapping his grand-son.

In the opinion of this Court, respondent No.4 had only met his grand-son and the aforesaid allegations of kidnapping against him, appear to be false and frivolous.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
