The instant petition had been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India by the petitioner for grant of parole under Sections 3 and 4 of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoner Temporary Release Act for a period of 08 weeks to attend his brother who is to undergo a surgery for removal of Gallstones and suffering from jaundice and also to cater to his household responsibilities that include repair work of the roof of his house.

Custody certificate dated 21.03.2022 has been filed by learned State counsel in the Court today, which is taken on record as per which the petitioner had absented for a period of 03 months and 27 days and had over-stayed.

In view of the same, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition.
