Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.29 dated 4.4.2019, registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Women, District Patiala.

By virtue of the order dated 1.10.2019, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the matter has been amicably settled in the Mediation Centre and the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 affirms the fact that the matter has been settled between the parties.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Varinder Kumar, has endorsed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 1.10.2019 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
