RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

Having argued the matter at length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that some of the issues have still not been addressed by the authorities, therefore, he be permitted to withdraw the petition, with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh representation in this regard.

Mr. Deepak Balyan, learned Additional Advocate General, appearing on behalf of the State of Haryana, on advance copy, submits that if any such representation is submitted by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and decided, by passing a detailed order, in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty prayed for.

However, it is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and, therefore, the authorities would be at liberty to examine the matter, taking all facts and facets into consideration, in accordance with law.
