Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.87 dated 02.06.2021 registered under Sections 188, 269, 270, 186, 332, 353, 147, 148, 149, 307, 379, 379-B and 506 IPC and Section 51-B Disaster Management Act, 2005 and Section 21(4) Mines and Minerals (Regulation of Development) Act, 1957 at Police Station Raipur Rani, Panchkula, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 13.07.2021, this Court had passed the following order:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the offence punishable under Section 307 IPC was incorporated for the alleged act of running over the complainant and others while driving the tractor. She has pointed out that the injuries allegedly suffered by the victim, are simple in nature.

This fact is not disputed by learned State counsel assisted by ASI Dharampal.

Adjourned to 10.11.2021.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal

and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigation Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C ”

Learned State counsel, who is instructed by SI Balbir Singh, states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 13.07.2021 is made absolute.
