The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 96 dated 21.06.2020 , registered under Sections 420 IPC and 24 of the Emigration Act, 1983, at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 29.07.2020, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail.

The parties are ad idem that in terms of the settlement arrived at between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, an amount of Rs.1.35 lacs is to be paid by the petitioner to respondent No.2.

Counsel for the petitioner has handed over a demand draft of Rs.1.35 lacs to counsel appearing for respondent No.2 as full and final settlement.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 29.07.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State assisted by counsel for respondent No.2 and on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 29.07.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
