The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.55 dated 28.03.2022 registered under Section 21(b) of NDPS Act, 1985 and (Sections 29, 61 and 85 of NDPS Act added later on) at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 25.05.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 25.05.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
