Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that against the order dated 12.01.2022 (Annexure P-4), vide which the punishment of recovery has been imposed upon the petitioner, he has filed an appeal before the Board of Directors on 03.03.2022 (Annexure P-5). Learned counsel further submits that the said appeal dated 03.03.2022 has not been decided by the respondents so far and pensionary benefits of the petitioner have been withheld by the respondents due to the said order of punishment dated 12.01.2022, which action of the respondents is causing prejudice to the petitioner, hence the respondents may kindly be directed to decide the appeal dated 03.03.2022, filed by the petitioner, in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Additional A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits

that in case, the appeal dated 03.03.2022, filed by the petitioner, has not

been decided so far, the needful will be done by the authorities concerned by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the submissions of learned State counsel, as recorded hereinbefore, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition at this stage and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.
