The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 10 dated 08.01.2018, registered under Sections 353, 186, 224, 225, 511 of the IPC at Police Station City Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted the concession of regular bail on 10.08.2018 by the trial Court and was regularly attending the court proceedings, however, during the COVID-19 period, he could not appear before the trial Court and vide order dated 30.09.2021, his bail/surety bonds have been cancelled and non-bailable warrants have been issued against him.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and apply for grant of fresh regular bail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the same, the present petition is disposed of with a

direction to petitioner to appear before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today and on doing so, the trial Court will release him on regular bail, subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Till the time the petitioner appears before the trial Court, his arrest shall remain stayed.

However, this will be subject to a condition that petitioner will deposit a cost of Rs. 5,000/- with the District Legal Services Authority, Sangrur.
