The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.37, dated 10.02.2019, under Sections 323 and 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it was on account of a matrimonial dispute between the parties that FIR in question came to be registered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 08.09.2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Umesh Kumar, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and co-operated with the investigating agency. However, she has submitted that in

the head note and prayer clause of the petitioner, the petitioner had not made a mention of offence under Section 406 of IPC.

On oral request of learned counsel for the petitioner, Section 406 of IPC is ordered to be added in the head note as well as in the prayer clause of the petition. Office to carry out necessary correction accordingly.

The learned State counsel on further instructions, has submitted that the petitioner is not required for further investigation, much less, for his custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 08.09.2021, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
