This is a petition seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 60 dated 9.6.2018, under Sections 458, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 459 and 325 IPC added later on) and (Sections 148 and 149 IPC deleted on 13.4.2021), registered at police Station Jaito, Tehsil Jaito, District Faridkot.

The petitioner during police investigation was found innocent and has been summoned by the trial court vide order dated 25.4.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR is of 2018 and the injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is granted interim bail subject to appearance before the trial court within 15 days from today. On his appearance, he shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the court concerned.

The petition is allowed.
