Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.15 dated 25.02.2021 registered under Sections 304, 34, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Daba, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition and states that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the police within a period of 10 days.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further made a prayer

that in case, the petitioner surrenders before the police within a period of 10 days from today and files an application for grant of regular bail after surrender, the same be decided as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 5 days from the date of filing of the said application.
