Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of order dated 11.05.2022 (P-2) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana whereby the bail granted to the petitioner has been cancelled and bail/surety bonds have also been cancelled and ordered to be forfeited to State. Non bailable warrants were also issued against the petitioner.

The petitioner is accused in case FIR No. 35 dated 29.03.2021, under Section 306 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana. He was granted regular bail by learned trial Court. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner was regularly appearing before the trial Court. On account of non-appearance of the petitioner on 11.05.2022, the bail was ordered to be cancelled and bail and surety bonds were ordered to be forfeited and non-bailable warrants were issued against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the non-appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court on 11.05.2022 was not intentional. In fact the petitioner was not well. Learned counsel for

the petitioner further states that it was never the intention of the petitioner to evade the process of law. He states that the petitioner is ready to surrender before learned trial Court and face trial.

Notice of motion.

Mr. B.S. Sewak, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State.

Taking into account the facts of the present case, this petition is disposed of with the observation that the petitioner may appear before the learned trial Court on the date fixed i.e. on 02.06.2022. On his doing so, he shall be released on interim bail by the trial Court subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to its satisfaction.

He shall also file an undertaking to continue appearing before the Court as and when required apart from following all the terms and conditions fixed in this respect.

Till 02.06.2022, the execution of the non-bailable warrants issued against the petitioner shall remain stayed.

However, it is clarified that if the petitioner does not appear on the date fixed, the present petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
