Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in criminal case having FIR No.144 dated 26.9.2014 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Division No.4, District Ludhiana City.

Counsel for the petitioners has *inter alia* contended that there was some dispute between the parties regarding sale of a plot which was owned by one Rajan Rawat but the dispute has already been settled between the parties and the said plot stands purchased by petitioner No.1 through his attorney petitioner No.2 from Rajan Rawat. He further submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation with the police in light of order of interim bail dated 26.5.2022.

State counsel on instructions from HC Satvir Singh has admitted the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial

In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 26.5.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
