Petitioner has approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.0385 dated 10.12.2017 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 66(E), 67, 67 (A) of Information Technology Act, 2000, Sections 384, 506, 354-D of IPC and Section 6 of Indecent Representation of Women (Prohibition) Act, 1986, registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, Distirct Ludhiana and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the bass of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties have amicably resolved their dispute and, thus, the FIR should be quashed.
