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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India seeking direction to official respondents to provide protection to the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 26.5.2022, petitioner No. 2 undertook to deposit Rs. 50,000/- (Rs. fifty thousand only) in the form of FDR in the name of petitioner No. 2.

Learned counsel for petitioners submits that petitioner No. 1 has deposited Rs. 50,000/- in the name of petitioner No. 2 vide Term Deposit Advice/Account No. 41139031492 dated 21.7.2022 of State Bank of India, SME Branch Ranipur, Bharat Electricals Township, Haridwar, Uttarakhand in favour of Miss. Anita Yadav (petitioner No. 2) for Rs. 50,000/-, a photocopy whereof has been filed in Court today and same is taken on record.

It is directed that the amount so deposited by petitioner No. 1 in the name of petitioner No. 2 be not encashed by either of the petitioners and be kept in the name of petitioner No. 2 until solemnization of their marriage.

In case, on petitioner No. 1 completing the age of 21 years or any time earlier, they decide not to solemnize marriage, then petitioner No. 2 will be at liberty to withdraw the amount. Petitioner No. 1 will have no claim of any kind on the said amount.

A copy of this order be also communicated to Manager of the concerned Branch of the Bank for information and necessary compliance.

With the above observations, petition is disposed of.
