The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for the issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take action against respondent Nos.4 to 6 mentioned in the representations dated 22.05.2017/31.05.2017 (Annexure P-1 colly).

The learned State counsel submits that as per para 2 of the reply dated 29.01.2018, inquiry in this case was conducted by ASI Sarabjit Singh, PS Mukerian and it was found that no offence was made out. Therefore, the application was consigned to the record room. This inquiry was further certified by the DSP and SSP and the file was consigned to the record room. Further, respondent Nos.4 to 6 were called in the Police Station and questioned and no incriminating evidence was found against them.
