Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.112 dated 2.5.2022 registered under Sections 147, 149, 294, 323, 427, 506 IPC at Police Station Nathusari Chopta, District Sirsa.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner who was not named in the FIR, has joined the investigation with the police in light of previous order of interim bail passed by this Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Satyawar has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that one motorcycle has been recovered from the petitioner and he is not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 26.5.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
