Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to restrain the private respondent Nos.4 to 6 not to harass or interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that apparently it is a marital dispute amongst the parties.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
